

## THE ANNUAL ECONOMIC IMPACT OF EMORY UNIVERSITY ON GEORGIA

Emory University, which includes Emory Healthcare, is a premier private teaching, medical, and research institution located in Atlanta. Emory is a top-ranked research university with a world-class health care system. Emory's excellent reputation in higher education is augmented by its cutting-edge research, global health initiatives, and advancements in the delivery of health care services, all of which work to serve humanity and improve societal conditions locally and globally.

Emory is a significant driver of economic activity for the state of Georgia. The results of this analysis include fiscal years 2022 and 2023.

## IN TOTAL:

- Emory produces **\$19.3 billion** of economic activity and directly or indirectly supports about **100,000** jobs statewide each year.
- Emory expends \$4.7 billion in total output, supporting 25,100 direct, indirect, and induced jobs and \$2.6 billion in earnings within the state of Georgia.
- Emory generates more than **\$347 million** in state tax revenues every year.
- Emory students inject an additional **\$472 million** a year in spending into the state.
- Alumni living and working in Georgia earn an additional \$1.3 billion a year due to the education and credentials they received from Emory.
- In 2023, Emory spent approximately \$257 million on goods purchased from Georgia-based suppliers.
